(Monochrome, Colour and Projected Image versions of the same image are permitted)

## PRINT LEAGUE COMPETITION RULES

### MONOCHROME

There are 3 Monochrome Print League Competitions during the Club season, points from which count towards The Rushworth Cup awarded at the end of the season.

1. Up to 3 prints may be entered in each competition.
2. Prints may be home or trade processed. Minimum size 15 x 10cm and mounted on card measuring 50 x 40cm. A title and the author's name must appear on the back.
3. Prints may be entirely toned in a single colour. Partial toning or the addition of colour is not permissible.
4. Each print will receive a mark out of 20 from the appointed judge who will also make awards of 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places and one Highly Commended place.
5. At the end of the Club season all the entrant's marks will be totalled for The Rushworth Cup.
6. In the event of a tie the positions shall be decided on the number of scores of 20, then 19 and so on.
7. Any print may be entered no more than twice in Monochrome Print League Competitions.
8. The source of the entire image must be the work of the author. The use of copyright free images is prohibited.
9. Please send a list of your prints by email to the Internal Competition Secretary – plus a digital file of each print sized 1400 x 1050 pixels maximum in sRGB colour space.
